- Manage budget with caucus and candidate to meet campaign goals.
- Partner with the caucus program and consultant team to ensure effective, timely, and winning paid communications.
- Work with state party leaders, labor groups, community leaders, and other allies to develop a strong political program and earn endorsements.
- Work with a fundraising consultant to ensure fundraising call time, events, and follow up to meet and exceed the goals of an aggressive finance plan.
- Manage social media, email, and earned media programs to ensure effective communications outreach.
